

Medical Procedures

It is our prayer that your group will have a safe camping experience. The following procedures will assist you in preparing for and dealing with the unexpected.

1. There are inherent risks to camping, therefore your group must have a specified Health Officer (minimum CPR/ first aid certified) who is responsible to dispense medications brought by children (17years and younger) and provide medical care and make decisions regarding medical treatment.
2. It is to your group's advantage to have a release form, signed by the parent/guardian, giving permission to seek medical care for all campers under the age of 18.
3. **If you need to call 911:** Phones are available for use in the kitchen of Sunrise Lodge and the Kitchen of Lakeview Lodge (dining hall). Dial: 9-7-911.

Please remember to bring with you:
 - A. A release form, signed by the parent/guardian, giving permission to seek medical care.
 - B. Camper insurance information
 - C. Camper's home/guardian phone number. Bair Lake recommends that you call the parents prior to the hospital trip when possible.
