It is so exciting to know that your child will be coming to Bair Lake Bible Camp to participate in the Adventure Challenge Education (ACE) program!

Here is what you need to know about the ACE program and what you need to pack for your child's fun-filled Adventure at Bair Lake Bible Camp:

To KNOW:

The **ACE course** focuses on developing team-building, group cohesiveness, communication, respect, positive risk-taking, and group problem solving skills. **Adventure education** is learning that incorporates all the elements of an adventure--surprise, stimulation, support, and significance. It will personally challenge the student/s to go beyond perceived boundaries, to think in new ways, and to work with others to solve problems. It also creates a common successful "cooperative learning" experience that students and staff can refer back to address current group challenges.

We are committed to creating a **fun** and **safe** environment where both group and personal growth can take place. The students will be guided by a trained facilitator through a challenge course that will have been specifically adapted to meet the needs and goals of the group.

To BRING:

- Clothes that should be loose enough to climb, run, and jump-- Clothes should be appropriate for the weather. (Rain, Cold, Warm, Snow, Etc...) Dressing in layers is recommended.
- Comfortable Closed-Toe Shoes that will support the options to climb, run, and jump.
- Bedding (Sleeping Bag/Pillow)
- Personal care items
- One outfit that can get ruined

Do NOT BRING:

- Radios, DVD or CD Players, iPods, mp3 players
- Illegal Substances, etc...
- Electronic games/beepers/cell phones
