Bair Lake Bible Camp Winter Blitz COVID Guidelines

Cohort Model

- Bair Lake Bible Camp has adopted the cohort model, which separates retreat attendees into several groups throughout the weekend. Each cohort will not need to socially distance within their cohort, but will need to keep at least 6 feet of physical distance from all other cohorts.
- Each youth group will be designated as their own cohort for the weekend. Individuals will be assigned to their own cohort.
- Social distancing and proper sanitation will be enforced between all cohorts. This will include meals, indoor gatherings, sleeping quarters, and all activities. Items should not be shared between cohorts unless they are properly sanitized.
- Masks will not be required, but are recommended indoors if 6 feet of physical distance cannot be kept between members of different cohorts.

Health Screenings

- Bair Lake Bible Camp's health screening procedures will be sent to all youth leaders. We require students to be screened before departure from their church. If anyone does not meet the screening qualifications, please do not allow them to come.
- Upon arrival at BLBC, each camper will be screened before being permitted to attend.
- Daily health screenings will be conducted Saturday and Sunday mornings. Each cohort will be given a thermometer and alcohol wipes to take temperatures. Any students or leaders who do not pass the daily health screening (have a fever or certain symptoms) will be quarantined and sent home for the safety of everyone else on grounds.

Meals

- Each cohort will be assigned to specific seating for their group and will be dismissed one at a time to go through the serving line. Food will be served cafeteria-style.

Free Time Activities

- Cohorts will be required to travel together for free time activities with a leader present.
- Activities will have designated lines that encourage cohorts to stay 6 ft apart.
- Broomball: Masks **will not** be required when playing within your cohort. Players and bystanders **will** be required to wear a mask when two different cohorts are playing one another.

Lakeview Lodge Game Room

- The game room is open and available for use. There is a sanitation station in the room. Sanitize the frequent touch points (e.g., ping pong paddles) of whatever games you are going to use both before and after use.

Common Restrooms (Lower Lakeview Lodge, PAC Gym, Bathhouse)

- Hand sanitizing will be required prior to entering the restroom. Please wash your hands after using the restroom and sanitize hands again after exiting the restroom. This system allows you to use restrooms worry free!
